Room 3 Term 1 Learning Overview 2021

ENGLISH

Genre Writing: Procedural texts will be the focus genre this term. Students will be viewing a range of procedural texts including directions, recipes and instruction manuals to identify the purpose, language features, structure and vocabulary before writing their own.

Reading Comprehension: Students will be consolidating their understanding of comprehension through the 'What do good readers do?' strategy as well as small group sessions focussing on individualised reading goals.

Spelling: Students will develop their spelling knowledge and vocabulary through focussing on a specific spelling rule each fortnight.

MATHS

Students will develop their skills and understanding of number in the following ways

- Recognising, modelling and representing numbers
- Applying place value to partition, rearrange and regroup numbers
- Recognise the connection between addition and subtraction
- Investigate number sequences and patterns

SCIENCE with Mr M

In Science, Earth & Space is the topic for this term and the students will learn about the movement of Earth, the moon, and the sun to suggest explanations for everyday observational changes.

HASS

Students will explore the question 'What makes Australia unique?' in relation to, natural and man-made landmarks, geography and climate, history, culture and flora and fauna. Students will present an oral presentation to share their findings with their peers.

Design & Technology

Students will be exploring tools, equipment and procedures to improve plant production when growing vegetables in the school garden and producing plant and animal environments such as a worm farm. Students will investigate sustainable composting practices and set up a whole school composting programme to reduce waste.

ARTS with Mrs Robertson

Our goal for this term is for your child to design a virtual game that promotes a positive message. With consultation, the children will be encouraged to select an app that allows them to become designers.

Health & Child Protections Curriculum

Students will be exploring the theme relationships including positive relationships, trust networks and power in relationships. Students will be discussing effective strategies to bounce back from loss, change and unhappy times.
