Literacy

Room 5 literacy will be taught between 8:45 – 11:00 am. It is important students arrive at school on time each day so they can familiarize themselves with the routine and don't miss out on important learning. Students will participate in grammar, spelling, handwriting, guided reading, and writing lessons. The writing topic for Term 1 is Procedural Texts. Students will be introduced to the purpose, structure and language features of instructions and recipes. They will participate in lessons to build their writing skills and write and publish their own simple recipe.

Students will participate in daily reading through D.E.A.R and guided reading groups, in which they will practice specific skills and work towards achieving their independent reading goals.

Library Borrowing

Our library borrowing day is **Wednesday**. This is part of our learning program in Room 5, and it is expected that all students participate in library borrowing each week.

Maths

The learning focus for maths this term is number and place value. Students will learn to identify, sequence and represent 2, 3 and 4 digit numbers. They will participate in daily activities to build upon their number knowledge, including ordering, sequencing, skip counting and problem solving.

Students will develop their understanding of how multi-digit numbers can be partitioned and how numbers are placed on a number line. We will also cover some financial mathematics later in the term, and students will learn to recognize and add small collections of coins and notes, as well as calculate change.
